

# Northern Division Young Adult Patroller National Ski Patrol Scholarship

NOTE: Deadline is May 15, 2017 – There will be 2 - \$500 Scholarships Available

The Northern Division honors the dedication of its Young Adult members with a college scholarship fund. The purpose of the award is to support a Young Adult Patroller in their college career. The scholarship is available to a Young Adult Patroller that is a registered member of the Northern Division - National Ski Patrol.

Up to two \$500 scholarships may be awarded each year.

## Eligibility

1. The applicant must currently be a registered member of the National Ski Patrol, Northern Division, and be 19 years of age or younger.
2. The applicant must intend to enroll in an accredited two or four-year college or university in the United States. Acceptance at an institution is not required for the application, but the applicant must be accepted before June 1 of the scholarship year.
3. Proof of acceptance at you chosen institution, must be provided by the winning applicant(s) before receiving the scholarship.
4. The applicant must be a student in good standing at an accredited public or private secondary or post-secondary school.
5. The applicant shall have a GPA of 2.75 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
6. The applicant must submit three (3) letters of support and recommendations from outside the applicant's own family. These letters shall support personal character, scholarship, and leadership potential.
7. The applicant shall submit a typed paragraph of no more than 250 words, discussing his or her professional interests, abilities, and intentions, as well as any special considerations related to the application. In short, the applicant should answer the questions, "Why do you deserve to be awarded a scholarship?"
8. A prior recipient of the scholarship is ineligible to apply for a subsequent scholarship.
9. Financial need is not a requirement for the award.
10. The application deadline is May 15, 2017.

Winning applicant(s) will be notified by June 1, 2017.
